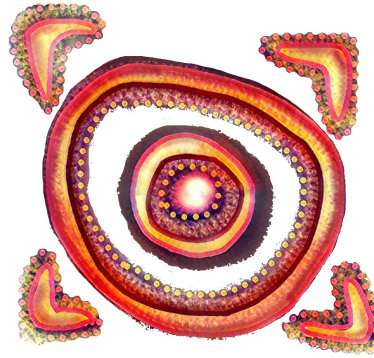
Social Justice

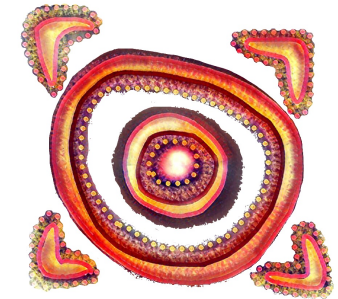
